



# Fees Policy

## 2024 Autumn Season Fees Policy Details:

Registration fees are comprised of a team fee which is set by Whitehorse Netball Association, along with a gym hire fee set by DCC and a fundraising and gifts levy, determined by the Ignite Netball Committee. These fees vary each season subject to cost increases or specific fundraising goals.

*The annual VNA insurance is paid separately by members and is set by Netball Victoria*

### Terms & Conditions:

Registration must be submitted by October 2023 to secure the player in a team, after this date, there is no guarantee of a spot. If the teams are at full capacity, they have the option to be a training partner or join a waiting list. If a player joins a team AFTER Round 3, they will be charged pro-rata season fees.

### Refund Policy:

VNA insurance fees are NOT refundable as per the Netball Victoria Policy, any issues or concerns with VNA need to be consulted with Netball Victoria.

If a player registers before the season commences and decides to withdraw their registration before teams are released a 20% cancellation fee will apply (unless medical reasons apply – certificate to be provided)

If a player withdraws after the teams are officially released, a 50% refund will be applied.

Once the season has commenced and a player is forced to withdraw due to extenuating circumstances (injury etc.) and misses more than 70% of the season then they may apply in writing for a pro-rata refund of club fees however the player will not be able to receive a VNA refund.
